

NEW MULTI-USE VIADUCT PATH OPENS JUNE 27



The Oregon Department of Transportation will open a new multi-use viaduct path on June 27.

The path starts east of the Knickerbocker Bridge and runs along the south side of the Willamette River until it joins a new path that the city of Springfield is building along Franklin Boulevard. The existing South Bank Path that crosses under Franklin Boulevard will close on June 30.

The new path:

- ◆ Eliminates dangerous curves
- ◆ Improves commuter safety for cyclists
- ◆ Offers beautiful views of the river and the Whilamut Passage Bridge
