You're invited to the bridge opening

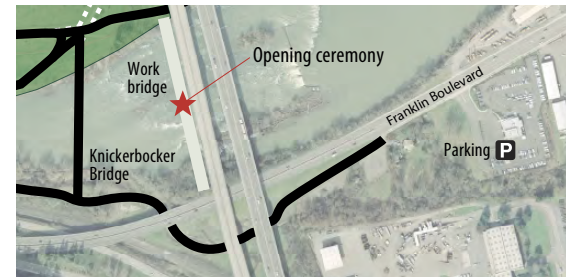
Thursday, Aug. 18, 2011 – 10 a.m. to noon

Please join U.S. Rep. Peter DeFazio, local elected leaders and ODOT officials to commemorate the opening of the new southbound Interstate 5 Willamette River Bridge. The event will include brief presentations, a reception and tours of the bridge.

The bridge will open two months earlier than estimated when construction began in August 2009. With the southbound bridge open, we will start building the new northbound Willamette River Bridge.

GETTING THERE

- The ceremony will take place on the work bridge located under the new bridge.
- Parking is available at the University of Oregon Motor Pool at 3233 Franklin Blvd. (see map below).
- Please allow 20 minutes to walk to the ceremony by following the signs. A courtesy shuttle will be available upon request.
- After the ceremony, guided walking tours will lead visitors around the work bridge or up on the southbound bridge. **Closed-toe shoes are required to participate in the tours.** Please plan for one hour to complete the tour.
