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SOCIOECONOMIC MONITORING OF PUBLIC LANDS MANAGEMENT: A COMPILATION OF MEASURES

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Collaborative groups, community leaders, and others want to increase the socioeconomic impacts of natural resource management. Monitoring can provide data to foster learning and improve socioeconomic conditions. Yet there is currently limited understanding of what and how to monitor.

To address this, we reviewed 12 existing guides or other resources on socioeconomic monitoring in a public lands context. We compiled the measures and methods suggested in each resource, and have indicated which measures are the most commonly found with shading. A bibliography of resources is on the last page of this document.

This compilation is intended to provide a quick reference list of socioeconomic measures and support initial conversations about monitoring. We recommend following these conversations with a structured process to collaboratively choose



desired measures, determine feasible methods, conduct baseline assessments, and implement an effective and useful monitoring plan.
