Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: Friday, June 21, 2013

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption with less than the required 35-day notice. Pursuant to ORS 197.830(2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

*NOTE: The Acknowledgment or Appeal Deadline is based upon the date the decision was mailed by local government. A decision may have been mailed to you on a different date than it was mailed to DLCD. As a result, your appeal deadline may be earlier than the above date specified. NO LUBA

ORDINANCE NO. 2620

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAKE OSWEGO CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN MAP AND ZONING MAP TO CHANGE THE DESIGNATIONS FROM PUBLIC (P) AND PUBLIC FUNCTIONS (PF), RESPECTIVELY, TO LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL (R-10) FOR REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1915 SOUTH SHORE BOULEVARD (Tax Lot 00100 of Tax Map 21E09 DD) [LU 12-0057].

WHEREAS, a notice of the public hearing for consideration of this Ordinance was duly given in a manner required by law; and,

WHEREAS, public hearings were held before the Planning Commission on March 25, 2013, and the Lake Oswego City Council on April 16, 2013, to review the proposed Comprehensive Plan Map and Zoning Map amendments;

The City of Lake Oswego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby adopts the Findings and Conclusions (LU12-0057) in Attachment A.

Section 2. The Comprehensive Plan Map and Zoning Map are hereby amended to change the designation for the property located at 1915 South Shore Boulevard (Tax Lot 00100, Map 21E09 DD) from Public (P) and Public Functions (PF), respectively, to Low Density Residential (R-10), as shown in Attachment B.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date of this Ordinance</u>: Pursuant to the Lake Oswego City Charter, Section 34, this ordinance shall be effective on the 30th day after its enactment.


Page 2 - FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS (LU 12-0057-1811)

As set forth in detail in the incorporated materials, the City Council finds that the proposal meets all applicable approval standards, including, without limitation, applicable provisions of the Lake Oswego Comprehensive Plan, the Lake Oswego Community Development Code, the Oregon Transportation Planning Rule and the Metro Urban Growth Management Functional Plan.

CONCLUSION

The City Council concludes that LU 12-0057 complies with all applicable criteria and should be approved. The Council also concludes that proposed Ordinance 2620, which implements LU 12-0057, should be enacted.
