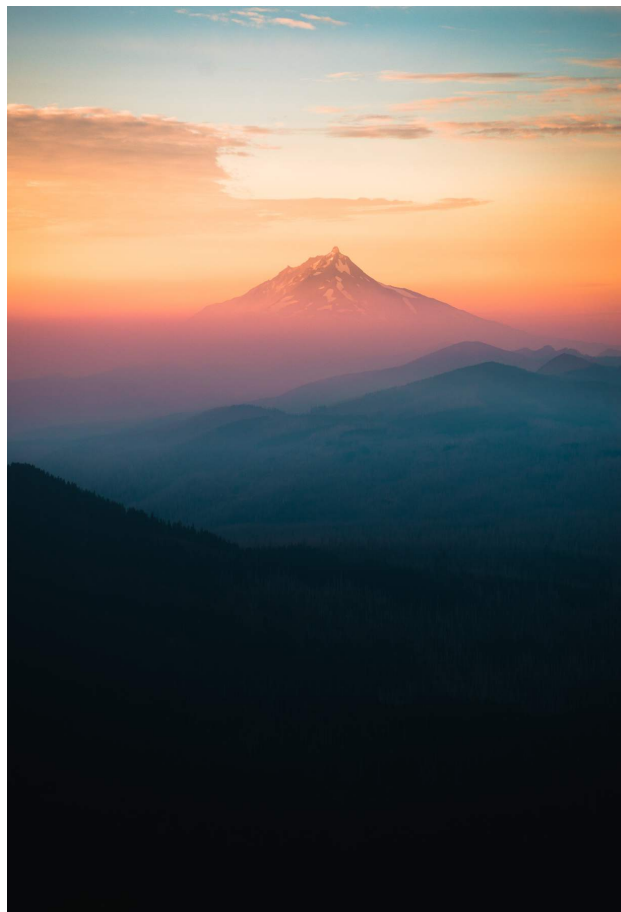




Cover Art—“Mountains Before The Eclipse”
