Hi Patricia,

I'm going off-line here to send you some documents that will help to contextualize some of the issues that Kate brings up below. The documents I've attached are the original organizing documents that helped shape the focus and structure of the gallery. I've also attached a 5-year budget plan that was created in collaboration with Doug and Kate. This document reflects their thinking on the resources that would be necessary to run the gallery in the way it was conceptualized. Clearly, these resources were never forthcoming, but this serves as the budget model for what could truly support a professional, academic gallery according to Kate and Doug. I thought reviewing these docs would help inform your response.

- 1. WB 5-yr Budget (last modified 2/15/11)
- 2. White Stag Proposal (last modified 5/21/09)
- 3. White Box Proposal AAD (last modified 7/20/10)
- 4. White Box Proposal Art (last modified 7/23/10)
- 5. White Box Proposal Art History (last modified 7/23/10)

Items 3, 4, and 5 were solicited from A&AA units when funding from UO Portland Academic Affairs Vice-Provost Wendy Larson was pulled. As you will recall, the White box was originally a 3-year experiment supported by Academic Affairs, who pulled funding after the first year and turned it over to A&AA. We are now in year 4 and it is evident that sustainable funding is not forthcoming from units beyond AAD and the A&AA Dean's office.

There is no question that White Box has been an exemplary endeavor. Extraordinary things have occurred in that space despite the limited budget and the skeleton staff. I truly wish it could reach its potential and that the funding that we all knew it would require were forthcoming.

Let's talk about this when you return.

## Dear Patricia,

Yes, I read both your memo and rationale, and understand that you thought this through carefully. However, my participation in, and/or response to, that process has been limited. In example, we had talked last month about budget support from my office and from Art to assist with Portland AAD program development and research, and a revised White Box budget model respectively. At that time I told you that I was unsure of what I had to contribute, was seeking clarity on budget issues, and wanted to know what was needed. I don't recall receiving a proposal from or additional conversation with you-all in that regard. Regarding Art, my recollection is that they would have a better sense of how they could contribute in March, and that there were other models to discuss with them.

I'm also concerned about AAD's, and UO's future relationships with partners like Ford Family Foundation, who have supported White Box infrastructure and publication grants, PICA, whose director serves on the White Box advisory committee, or the future of any White Box conversation within the School if we have to close it down after establishing such an impressive growth arc. Regarding professionalism, I'm not sure to what you're referring, but public perception of the White Box is very positive, and professional enough to have been named best new gallery and invited to join the very picky PADA group.

I regret losing the opportunity for further discussion and nuanced planning. Thanks, Kate

Dear Doug and Kate,

I'd like to take a moment to respond to your two messages of yesterday, Kate, as well as Doug's message of yesterday evening.

The memo that was attached to the initial message I sent yesterday outlined the specific reasons for my decision. I've attached this memo again for easy reference.

This decision was made with very careful and thoughtful consideration, and I would like to reemphasize that AAD will certainly consider investing in the White Box Gallery within the context of the restructuring, realignment, and initiation of collaborative Portland-based programs. AAD has invested more than \$80,000 in the White Box Gallery so far, and while we are eager to see this gallery continue its excellent work, our program's finances will not allow for continuation of this annual investment in its current unsustainable structure.

As you know, AAD continues to invest heavily in developing entrepreneurial programs and initiatives that are Portland based. We welcome the opportunity to continue the conversation with our academic partners about museum studies, curatorial studies, and the White Box, but our small academic unit is not able to unilaterally support these initiatives.
