**The purpose of this assignment is to think critically about the resources that you are using for your final project (or, in a real-life scenario, for a research project) to decide if these are appropriate, relevant sources for your project. Your responses should be typewritten.**

- A. Find **two** web sites with information on your topic. You may use any method you wish to find these two web sites (for example, use an Internet search engine such as Yahoo or Google (<http://www.google.com>)).

Using the criteria on the *Evaluating Information on the World Wide Web* page (<http://libweb.uoregon.edu/subguid/psychology/evaluate.html>) as a guideline, evaluate these web sites. I expect to see a thorough, thoughtful evaluation of these sites which addresses, but is not limited to each of the categories on the *Evaluating Information* web page.

Please attach a print out of the home (first) page of each web site to your evaluation. You do not need to provide a MLA or APA style citation for these sources.

- B. Evaluate two print resources you plan to use in your final project. These two sources can be books, government documents, journal articles, or any other source you choose which you found in print (not electronic) form (i.e. this does not include any item that you found full-text online and printed out from a computer). Apply the criteria used above to evaluate world wide web documents to evaluate these print resources. As above, I expect to see a careful, well thought-out evaluation of these sources, which includes (but isn't limited to) the criteria on the *Evaluating Information* page.

Please cite these two print resources in MLA or APA style and include these citations with your evaluation of these resources.
