Recently, when a former student of mine told me that he'd seen "Charlie and the Chocolate Factory" in Taiwan this summer, I felt a certain wistful twinge. What a pity, I thought, that so many top-drawer Asian movies--like Hayao Miyazaki's "Howl's Moving Castle," for example—don't play in mainstream U.S. theaters. There is a slow increase in the number of foreign films coming to the American screen, but it is still a mere trickle compared to the flood of blockbusters being exported.

This is also true of T.V. shows. A few years back, Japanese dramas swept Asia like a storm, displacing even some of the American sitcom imports. More recently, Korean dramas have been bringing tears to their Asian audiences as well. But if I turn on the T.V. here in the U.S., I don't feel the slightest breeze from this veritable tempest.

Likely one reason for this imbalance is that the U.S. entertainment industry is more sophisticated and its products more lavishly funded and marketed, thereby propelling American pop culture to the four corners of the world. But I can't help wondering how many foreign gems are lost in this all-consuming wave called "Hollywood."

Entertainment and pop culture are only a fraction of a country's cultural contribution. If we consider all the other aspects of the world that we tend to turn blind eyes and deaf ears to, how ignorant we truly are!

Perhaps that's why many UO students decide to learn a second language. Through language, one is naturally exposed to the culture—traditional and modern—of the people who live and breathe it. *Global Talk* hopes to open this window further, by bringing another breeze of cultural understanding to the UO campus. In this issue, the wind of "cool" will take you across parts of Asia and Europe, starting with Jay Chou, the coolest rap/hip hop artist in China and Taiwan. Brace yourself and enjoy! (And yes, in case you're wondering, he's been the biggest thing on the Asian Pacific Rim for a number of years now.)

Senegal Defers Case to African Union

The government of Senegal has decided to hand-over the case of former Chadian president Hissène Habré to the African Union. A Belgian court has requested the extradition of Mr. Habré, who has been living in Senegal for the last fifteen years, for the torture and murder of political prisoners when he was in power. This case has become a test of whether former heads of state should be judged in foreign courts, especially in the case of former African heads of state being extradited to former colonial powers such as Belgium.

Paris Hotels Fined

Six of Paris' most prestigious hotels have been fined for sharing commercial information, helping to keep prices artificially high. The Crillon, Bristol, Meurice, Piazza Athenee, Ritz and George V hotels were accused of operating a cartel by competition regulators. A four-year investigation found they shared details of room rates averaging more than 700 euros (£480) a night. The six establishments have been fined a total of 709,000 euros.

2 egg yolks

1/4 c. milk

1 tsp. vanilla

3 1/2 c. sifted cake flour

Directions: Cream butter until soft, add sugar and beat. Add honey and egg yolks. Add milk, vanilla, and beat. Add flour gradually. Beat after addition. Chill dough. Roll out and cut. Bake 10 minutes at 375 degrees. Cool and frost with white or chocolate icing.

CeBIT 2006 to take place 9 March to 15 March

CeBIT in Hannover is Germany's giant trade fair for all things technological: The CeBIT 2006 motto is 'Digital Solutions for Work & Life'. It is the only trade fair worldwide that showcases the entire spectrum of information and communications technology. There will be 6,000 exhibitors from 70 countries - plus approx. half a million visitors, including 128,000 from outside Germany. "CeBIT is the no. 1 event for the sector," a CeBIT official stated. This year's focus: convergence. It is a definite trend in the ICT business, since it is impossible to overlook the way in which computers are shaping work and home life and how these two worlds are merging.

¾ cup water

¾ cup white sugar

1 cinnamon stick

1 orange

10 whole cloves

1 (750 milliliter) bottle red wine

Directions:

In a saucepan, combine the water, sugar, and cinnamon stick. Bring to a boil, reduce the heat, and simmer.

Cut the orange in half, and squeeze the juice into the simmering water.

Push the cloves into the outside of orange peel, and place peel in the simmering water. Continue

Chechnyan Leader Meets With Guerrillas

November 28, 2005 GROZNY, CHECHNYA:

The President of the republic of Chechnya, Alu Alkhanov stated on Monday that he will meet with leaders of a former guerilla organization in Brussels. This group was headed by chief Aslan Maskhadov. Alkhanov said that Chechnya granted amnesty and gave jobs to rebel militants who voluntarily sought reform. About 7,000 former guerillas have been pardoned so far and as more come forward peacefully they will also be pardoned. 41 Arrested Protesting Army School in Georgia

Nov. 21, 2005 - Associated Press - The Rev. Jerry Zawada has already served a federal prison term for trespassing on government property to protest a Fort Benning school he blames for human rights abuses in Latin America.

On Nov. 20th, the 68-year-old Catholic priest risked another one. Zawada was among at least 41 protesters arrested during an annual protest calling for the closing of the Western Hemisphere Institute for Security Corporation, formerly known as the Army's School of the Americas.

School of the Americas Watch, the group that sponsors the annual rally, alleges the school's graduates have committed murders, rapes and tortures in Latin America. Military officials deny the charges.

Citing growing concerns about the war in Iraq and reports of torture by U.S. soldiers, organizers predicted a record turnout of 19,000 - 2,000 more than last year. The protest has been held every year since 1990.

Protesters are arrested each year when they enter the Georgia military reservation. The Army added a second fence topped by razor wire last year, and erected a third fence this year, but the protesters - even the older ones like Zawada - seem to find a way to scale or get past them.

The protests are timed to coincide with the anniversary of the November 1989 murders of six Jesuit priests, their housekeeper and her daughter in El Salvador. A congressional panel concluded that some of the killers were SOA graduates.

AFRICA: Craig Higginson, a former pupil of Michaelhouse, a prestigious boys' school in the Kwa-Zulu Natal Midlands, has won an award in the UK for his play "Laughter In The Dark". Craig received the honor at this year's 2004-05 Sony Academy Radio Awards. His winning play was inspired by a novel by Vladimir Nabokov, and was first performed at the Royal Shakespeare Company in Stratford-upon-Avon, after which it was adapted for radio as a result of a BBC Radio 3 commission. He is now waiting to hear if the play will be taken to the national theatre in London.

PHILLIPPINES: In collaboration with Canary Films, Director Jose Javier Reyes is producing a new movie of the psychological-thriller genre for the third straight year. The movie will be seen at the Metro Manila Film Festival (MMFF) via the upcoming Kutob. The film stalks 2003's *Malikmata* and 2004's *Spirit of the Glass*, both box-office winners and still under Canary Films. Starring Rica Peralejo, Alessandra de Rossi, and Ryan Agoncillo, *Kutob* tells the story of Erica (Peralejo) and her problematic boyfriend, Carlo (Agoncillo). With her bestfriend, Mayen (De Rossi). Erika consults a fortune-teller about her boyfriend's suspected womanizing. The plot thickens when the fortune-teller tells Erica of darker mishaps to come—something that the latter brushes aside. As differences between Erika and Carlo escalate, meddling friends enter the picture; one even secretly obsessing with Erika. As Erika reconciles with Carlo, friend Marvin makes his moves. At this point the fortune-teller's prediction hounds: Will it come true at last or is the denouement up to the hands of its actors?

PAKISTAN: Sanjay F. Gupta's latest film, "Zinda", starring Sanjay Dutt, John Abraham, Lara Dutta, Celina Jaitley and Mahesh Manjrekar, is a song-less thriller, but the film's audio album features songs by Sanjay Dutt and John Abraham. Talking about the album, the director says, "Rocking music is something my films are associated with, so I couldn't give it a miss in *Zinda*. It has been a tremendous experience creating the music for a thriller; however, the tracks have not been incorporated in the film." A special five-minute video of the track, *Yeh hai meri kahaani*, aired on MTV on November 20, kicking off the promotional campaign for the film, which releases on January 13 2006. This is the first time that a Bollywood film campaign will start with a music video in the promotional stages, shot in an old recording studio, without any film visuals. It is a revolutionary step not only for the Bollywood film industry, but all around the world.

ROMANIA: Produced by the Cinema Creation Studios of the Romanian Cultural Ministry and Parnasse Production and co-produced by Scarabee Films in 1992, "the Oak" is a movie you must see. This vitriolic comedy, set during the Romanian dictator Ceausescu's horrific regime, follows a wild and aimless woman to the countryside, where she hopes to put her dead father's ashes -- and her internal chaos -- to rest. She takes up with a mouthy, iconoclastic doctor; together they, and the country, step shakily into a new era.
