ANNUAL REPORT HIGHLIGHTS ON GRANT AND CONTRACT ACTIVITY FISCAL YEAR 2002-03

OVERVIEW

University of Oregon faculty received over \$77.5M in research grants and contracts for the Fiscal Year ended June 30, 2003. The record-high total of \$77,763,176 in awards was a 3.6% increase over the prior record year, FY 2001-02.

Direct federal funding to UO totaled \$54,767,149. Direct federal and sub-federal dollars (sub-federal funds are passed through to UO from prime-grantee entities, such as other universities, non-profits, and state and local governmental agencies) totaled \$69,305,081, or 89% of the total funding received by the UO. The total level of federal dollars in FY 03 is a 5.5% increase over the prior year's federal support. Significant increases in funding from individual federal agencies included the National Science Foundation (13.5% increase), U.S. Department of Education (18% increase), Environmental Protection Agency (7.5-fold increase), and U.S. Department of Transportation (5-fold increase).

Private foundations and corporations provided funds totaling \$3.4M, but total support from all private sponsors, including non-public entities that pass-through federal funds to UO, totaled \$9.2M. State of Oregon agencies awarded grants and contracts to the UO totaling nearly \$4.6M, including direct state and sub-federal pass-through funds.

Award totals are normally attributed to the submitting department or research institute or center, under the organizational unit—such as a college, school, or the vice president for research office—to which they report for research administration. This format clearly indicates the depth and breadth of interdisciplinary research at the UO. The research centers and institutes reporting to the Vice President for Research are attributed with 52% of total grants and contracts received, while the College of Education received 27% and the College of Arts and Sciences received 14%.

For the first time, the Annual Report includes award totals by the home department (the academic unit where the faculty member is appointed) of the principal and co-principal investigators, which reflects the strength of faculty research in each academic department. The faculty home departments are primarily in the College of Education (32%) and the College of Arts and Sciences (58%), as reflected in the awards section of the Annual Report.

Awards support a variety of activities classified as either research, instruction, or public service, or some combination. However, when awards are identified by their primary purpose, as follows, research accounts for nearly three-fourths of these activities:

Research \$54.6 million (70.3%)
Instruction \$6.3 million (8.1%)
Public Service projects \$16.9 million (21.6%)

Over 770 proposals were submitted with requests totaling \$104.8M in first-year funding. Seventy-one percent of dollars requested were for new and competitive renewal grants. The total number of new and competitive renewal grants increased 15% over the previous fiscal year, accounting for 84% of the total number of applications processed in FY 03. Proposals for federal and sub-federal support totaled \$94M or 89% of total dollars requested.

Expenditures in all active grants and contracts during the fiscal year totaled a record level \$75.9M. Expenditure totals do not match the award totals for the same fiscal year, since grants are received throughout the year and funds are spent over multiple fiscal periods. Research-related costs were 68% of the total expenditures, while academic departments and other programs accounted for the remaining 32%. Personnel costs represented about 46.9% of grant and contract expenditures, or \$35.6M last fiscal year, with another \$26.8M going for services, supplies, equipment and miscellaneous expenditures.

Facilities and Administrative (F&A) or indirect cost recovery totaled \$13.7M in FY 03, and 58% of the total recovered was returned directly to departments, centers and institutes, specialized labs, and shared scientific facilities, as additional research support. The remainder of indirect cost recovery supports general administration, research administration, facilities maintenance and operations, OUS administration and new building costs.






DOLLARS REQUESTED BY AGENCY TYPE




DOLLARS REQUESTED BY FEDERAL AGENCY



FY 03 PROPOSAL SUBMISSIONS REQUESTED FUNDING BY APPLICATION TYPE





FACILITIES AND ADMINISTRATIVE (F&A) COSTS









