### ANNUAL REPORT HIGHLIGHTS ON GRANT AND CONTRACT ACTIVITY FISCAL YEAR 2004-05

#### **OVERVIEW**

### AWARDS

The University of Oregon received nearly \$84 million from external funding sources in grants, contracts and other competitive awards for fiscal year 2004-05. This represents the second highest total in award dollars ever recorded at the UO, as shown on the awards chart "A Multi-Year Summary of Public and Private Support".

Direct federal funding to UO totaled \$60.5 million. Direct federal funding plus sub-federal dollars (sub-federal funds are "flow-through" dollars allocated by other entities, such as universities, non-profits, and state and local governmental agencies, to the UO in support of research) totaled \$77.1 million in FY05, an 11% increase over the prior year. Federal funding accounted for 92% of the total funding received by the UO in FY05, as shown in the awards charts. Significant increases in federal support were realized in FY05 over the prior fiscal year from the National Science Foundation (a 15% increase to \$14.1 million) and the U.S. Department of Education (a 13% increase to \$29.3 million), while support from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, including the National Institutes of Health, remained steady at \$24.1 million in FY05.

Private foundations and corporations provided funds totaling \$2.7 million, and support from all private sponsors, including non-governmental entities that pass-through federal funds to UO, totaled \$5.2 million. State of Oregon agencies awarded grants and contracts to the UO totaling nearly \$6.9 million, from both state funds and sub-federal pass-through funds. Grants received for specialized research equipment totaled \$3 million. Training grants and fellowships for students and faculty totaled \$8.4 million.

Nearly 550 awards were made to 224 faculty serving as principal investigators (PI) in fiscal year 2004-05. The College of Education received \$30.2 million in FY05, an 11% increase over the prior fiscal year. Research centers and institutes outside the College of Education received \$39.9 million. Details on awards received by college and submitting unit, over several years, are found in the awards charts.

Tenured and tenure-track faculty are generally appointed through an academic department, where instruction, public service and some research activities are their primary functions. However, interdisciplinary research and collaboration is a hallmark at the UO, and many faculty manage their externally-funded research programs through a research center or institute. The proposals are submitted by, and awards are made to, the centers and institutes as opposed to the academic unit. Charts on "Awards by Proposal Submitting Unit" and "Awards by Home Unit of the PI and co-PI" reflect this breakdown. For example, the research centers and institutes that report to the Vice President for Research are attributed with 46% of total award dollars, whereas 52% of the PIs and co-PIs are appointed in academic departments of the College of Arts and

Sciences. Another chart provides details on award totals for faculty by home unit (the academic department where the PI or co-PI is appointed), reflecting the strength of faculty research in their various academic departments.

Awards are categorized as primarily supporting research, instruction, or public service activities. Grants and contracts in FY 05 are reported by their primary purpose as follows:

- Research \$57.5 million (68.7%)
   Instruction \$5.5 million (6.6%)
- Public Service \$20.7 million (24.7%)

### **PROPOSALS**

Over 780 proposals were submitted requesting \$111.5 million in first-year funding. Eighty-one percent of total proposal submissions were for new and competitive renewal grants, requesting \$79.5 million in first-year funding. Sixty-one percent of total proposal submissions requested federal support totaling \$95.3 million, or 85.5% of total dollars requested. The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, including the National Institutes of Health, accounted for almost half of the federal dollars requested, while the U.S. Department of Education was 14% and the National Science Foundation was 17% of federal support requested.

Proposals submitted to private foundations and corporations represented 20% of the total proposal submissions, requesting \$10.2 million or 9% of total dollars requested.

### **EXPENDITURES**

Expenditures on over 1200 active grants and contracts during the 2004-05 fiscal year totaled a record \$86.4 million for direct and F&A (indirect) costs. Expenditure totals do not match the award totals for the same fiscal year, as grants are received and reported during a fiscal year but the funds can be spent over multiple fiscal years. Personnel costs represented 60% of direct expenditures, or \$42.2 million last fiscal year, with another \$28.4 million spent for services, supplies, equipment and miscellaneous project-related expenses. Research activities accounted for 72% of the total expenditures, while academic departments and other programs expended the remaining 28%.

### FACILITIES AND ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS

Facilities and Administrative (F&A) or indirect cost recovery totaled \$15.8 million in FY 05. The federally-negotiated F&A rate budgeted for research activities was 49% (other activities use different rates or do not allow F&A to be charged), but only 18% of actual expenditures in FY05 was for F&A costs, resulting in a significantly lower "effective rate" for recovering facilities and administrative costs campus-wide. Of the total \$15.8 received for F&A costs, 56.5% of the total received was reallocated directly in support of faculty as costshare or matching funds, new

faculty start up costs, and for other faculty research needs, as well as for research center and institute administration, specialized labs and shared research facilities. The remainder of F&A cost recovery supports general university administration, research administration, facilities maintenance and operations, OUS administration and new building costs. A breakdown of F&A funds received over time and allocations by cost component are found in the F&A charts.







### **REQUESTED FUNDING BY APPLICATION TYPE**


### NUMBER SUBMITTED BY AGENCY TYPE
